How to publish an ebook

- 1. Write the ebook. Make sure you have edited it or have had someone edit for you. Try getting a few friends to read your ebook.
- 2. Create a professional book cover for the ebook. Make sure that the cover is the correct sizing for Smashwords or Bookbaby (check on their websites). Add your name and title to the book cover. You DO NOT NEED AN ISBN NUMBER for an ebook. *Amazon will give you one for free*. And, you do not one for the ereader.
- 3. Save the ebook in three formats. Save the ebook in a .doc (word format), .pdf and an epub format. You will need to keep the ebook in a .pdf format if you share it with your friends or if you want to send it to publishing companies for them to review the book. Publishing companies may really like your ebook and want to put it in print for you (read submissions policy on publishing websites). By putting your ebook in .pdf format no one can change the content. It's permanently saved. By putting your ebook in an .epub format ALL of the ereaders will be able to read it with out any error. Therefore, no matter what sort of ereader someone has he or she will be able to read your ebook. There are many *free* epub converter programs that you can find by using google.
- 4. Decide if you want to distribute your ebook on your own or have someone else to do it for you. There are many ways you can distribute your ebook online
 - Bookbaby (fees start at \$99)
 - Createspace (free)
 - Googleplay (free)
 - Ibook (free)
 - Kindle Direct Publishing for Amazon (kdp.amazon.com) (free)
 - Smashwords (free)

I would recommend doing it all on your own. It really is very easy.

STEP ONE: Go to Smashwords, create an account and upload your ebook and cover. Smashwords will distribute it for free to ALL ereaders.

STEP TWO: Go to Kindle Direct Publishing, create an account and upload your ebook. After the ebook has been approved you will be able to see it on Amazon.

STEP THREE: Create a profile on Amazon Author Central (you will need to make two accounts, one for the UK and one for the USA). For some reason they do not merge the two countries together. This is the location where you tell your readers a little bit about yourself and what the ebook is actually about.

You can also add your ebook to google play as well as itunes (if you have a MAC computer). I would recommend using a MAC because you can do all sorts of cool things with a MAC in the publishing programs that it offers.

tip: Smashwords will not upload the ebook if it's not in the correct .epub format. It may be tricky if you have pictures in the ebook. Often, ereaders work best if the ebook is full of text ONLY. If you cannot upload your ebook to Smashwords because there are pictures and you do not want to pay, then you can manually go through all of

the ereader channels (by going to their website) and adding the ebook to every ereader available: apple ipad, iphone, ipod touch, kindle, kindle fire, sony reader, barns and nobles nook, kobo and googleplay.

5. After you have uploaded your ebook on Amazon don't forget to get people to review it! That will help spread the word! After all, marketing your ebook is key to sales!
